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UGL secures \$170 million in new projects

- Various new locomotive orders including the supply of 6 x C44ACi locomotives to supplement Chicago Freight Car Leasing Australia's existing locomotive fleet and 2 x C44ACi locomotives to Pacific National Rail, expanding their existing 93 class fleet.
- New contracts with TransGrid for the replacement of the Griffith 132kV substation transformers and secondary systems as well as the replacement of the Tumut 132/66kV substation secondary systems and associated civil and electrical works.
- A third contract extension for Sydney Water's Priority Sewerage Program (PSP) to deliver additional wastewater services to six communities in environmentally sensitive areas around Sydney. Stage 3 of the PSP will be delivered over the next two years.
- Approximately \$50 million in various asset maintenance contracts across the oil and gas, minerals processing, transport and social infrastructure sectors across Australia.

Our ability to secure new streams of recurring revenue and the continued strength of our relationships across a diversified blue-chip client base demonstrates the breadth of our capabilities and our ability to deliver innovative solutions to our clients across all of the sectors in which we operate."
